RIIERR302D: Respond to local emergencies and incidents

RIIERR205D: Apply initial response first aid

This grouping of units offers the information and skills participants need to respond to local emergencies and apply initial response first aid in operational roles. Participants will gain knowledge in site emergency situations, interpreting geological data, communication systems and firefighting techniques to better allow them to respond to emergencies and incidents. Participants will also receive an understanding of safety data sheets, incident reporting systems and procedures, duty of care, resuscitation, bleeding control and care of casualties.

This nationally accredited training consists of both theory and practical sessions.

Participants must have a sound knowledge of the English language.
