



CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (QLD White Card)

This course is an introduction into safe work practices for workers in the construction industry and provides understanding and knowledge needed to commence or continue work within the building and construction industry. It is designed to meet Workplace Health and Safety requirements for a site safety induction and must be achieved before access to any building and construction site.

White card training must be delivered face to face in Queensland, subject to the exemption for students residing in a rural area (100km or more from any RTO offering face to face delivery of the course).

This nationally accredited training consists of both theory and practical sessions.

Participants must have a sound knowledge of the English language.
