HLTAID011 Provide First Aid:

Through First Aid and CPR training you will learn the skills you need to respond to a medical emergency so you can save lives and reduce pain and injury until qualified medical help takes over. First Aid is the initial assistance or care of a suddenly sick or injured person or persons. It is the vital initial care given as soon as possible after an accident or illness.

HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR):

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is the name given to the technique of combining external cardiac compressions with rescue breaths. CPR may be required in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to perform CPR in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.
