Incident Investigation – RIIWHS301D Conduct Safety and Health Investigations

- Determining objectives
- Gathering and evaluating information
- Identifying actions and making appropriate recommendations to reduce risk of a recurrence
- Presenting reports

Communicate information – RIICOM301D Communicate Information

- Verbal and written communication
- Achieving meeting outcomes
- Delivering a presentation
- Negotiating in the workplace
