CPCCWHS1001: Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (QLD White Card)

This course is an introduction into safe work practices for the construction industry. It is designed to meet Workplace Health and Safety requirements for a site safety induction and must be achieved before access to any building and construction.

White card training must be delivered face to face in Queensland, subject to the exemption for students residing in a rural area (100km or more from any RTO offering face to face delivery of the course.)

Once assessed as competent the participant will receive an official Workplace Health & Safety white card.

Participants must have a sound knowledge of the English language.

- WHS communication processes, including the role of representatives
- Basic principles of risk management
- Prevention of injury and illness in the workplace
- Interpreting common safety signs and symbols
- First aid, fire safety and personal protection equipment
