MSMWHS201 Conduct Hazard Analysis:

This unit of competency covers the skills and knowledge required to conduct a hazard analysis.

It is not intended to apply to simpler routine hazard checks, such as 'Take 5', Step Back 5x5', five step or similar. A hazard analysis is a process where all of the dangers associated with a specific job are identified and appropriate controls are selected to reduce the chance and degree of damage or harm.

This unit is a pre-requisite to MSMPER300 Issue Work Permits.

MSMPER300 Issue Work Permits:

This unit of competency applies to personal who are required to issue appropriate permits to work, to persons conducting a variety of activities in workplace environments in which hazards exist or specific procedures need to be followed and monitored to protect the safety of personnel and the integrity of plant or process.

This unit of competency also applies to an individual working alone or as part of a team or group and working in liaison with other shift team members and the control room operator, as appropriate.

- Prerequisites apply to this unit of competency.
- Participants may only be granted competency in this unit after achieving competency in the unit MSMWHS201
 Conduct hazard analysis.
