

RIIHAN301E Operate Elevating Work Platform

This unit covers the operation of elevating work platforms up to 11 meters or under in the resources and infrastructure industries. Participants will receive specific training in the scissor lift, an aerial platform that provides more space than a regular boom-type EWP and can be raised or lowered but has no ability to slew or telescope. Participants will also receive training in understanding associated hazards and risk management controls, strengths and limitations of the equipment, and the relevant inspection and maintenance requirements.

This nationally accredited training consists of both theory and practical sessions.

Participants must have a sound knowledge of the English language.
