

UETDRMP018 Perform Rescue from a Live Low Voltage Panel HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation:

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is the name given to the technique of combining external cardiac compressions with rescue breaths. CPR may be required in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to perform CPR in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

UETDRMP018 Perform Rescue from a Live Low Voltage Panel:

This unit includes the skills and knowledge required to rescue a person in contact with low voltage live electrical conductors and equipment. It also covers the requirements and processes for a person to carry out a risk assessment of an electrically hazardous situation and to perform low voltage rescue procedures without hazard to themselves or others. It is a **pre-requisite** requirement of this unit that the learner has successfully completed the unit HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation.
